Kia ora,

A huge well done to all of the children who took part in the Rural Schools Senior Swimming last Friday. Those who organised the Senior Swimming Sports have selected a team to represent the Rural Schools at Bush Swimming this coming Friday. The children selected have been notified.

We had a great day yesterday when we hosted Junior Swimming Sports. Our Huia children were amazing running games for the younger children. Thank you to all of the parents who helped, especially Jane who spent two hours in the pool. Thank you also to ASCA for organising the BBQ. Thank you to Mrs Bond who ensured that all of the children got to their next activity on time. These events are so successful because the school and community work so well together.

Thank you to all those who have returned the Vision and Values questionnaire. It would be wonderful if every family could complete and return their form by Friday 10th March. This is the first time since 2016 that they have been reviewed. Please take this opportunity to tell us what you think. Children and staff will also be asked for their views.

On Friday 24th March we will be holding a Whanau Quiz Afternoon in the hall. Mrs Bond will once again be challenging you and your children. We will begin at 1pm with a shared lunch, please bring a plate to the hall for 12.45pm or send it to school with your child if you are unable to join us. This is a very enjoyable event and an opportunity for you to have fun as a family and a community. We hope that as many of you as possible will be able to come.

Last week we held a Black and White fundraiser to support a local school who was affected by Cyclone Gabrielle. \$297.70 will be sent to Tinui School along with some library books and junior readers. Thank you for your support.

Attendance is a focus for all schools throughout New Zealand and it is being tracked carefully. Attending school 90% or more of the time is our target. Currently 34 (83%) of our children are at school for at least 90% of the time. Eleven of our children have 100% attendance. Missing school impacts on your child's progress. If you miss one day a week, that is equivalent to missing almost one term of school over a year.

If your child is absent from school, please email or phone the school office explaining why they are absent. Telling the bus driver that they are not at school isn't enough. We have to record a reason for their absence on our school roll. If we don't hear from you, we can only assume that they are truant. If your child is sick or has an appointment that is an acceptable reason for not coming to school and will be recorded as such. If your child doesn't want to come to school, or there is another issue preventing regular attendance please come and talk to me so that we can find ways to support you.
