Kia ora,

Please can you let school know if your child has a change in prescription medication or is given new medication which they may need to take at school as we need you to complete a form telling us. This is for all prescription medication including inhalers.

We are currently updating our Physical Restraint Policy in line with new rules and guidance from the Ministry. The new policy will come into effect on May 7th and will be available for viewing, after that date, on SchoolDocs. Staff are currently completing online modules to become familiar with the new guidance. If you would like any further information don't hesitate to ask.

We will be sending out a volunteer transport form to all families today. We are required to hold information for anyone who transports children to events. These will be held for a calendar year. If you offer to transport children please can you complete and return it as soon as possible. If you have any questions please ask.

If you make any changes to afternoon buses, even if it is on your normal route, please let school know. We need to know where every child is being dropped off in case there is an emergency or there is a relief driver on that route.


