

I hope that you all had a good Waitangi day yesterday.

Year 7 Technology

Camp 2024

This year our Year 5, 6 and 7's will be spending a week at Forest Lakes near Otaki. The children will leave on Monday 20th May and return on Friday 24th May. Due to the awesome fundraising by ASCA there will be no charge for camp. We have a limited number of places for parents to come as camp helpers. If you would like to come, please let me know as soon as possible (by the 28th February). If more parents want to come than we can accommodate, names will be drawn out of hat.

Learning Term One - Huia Class

The topic focus is the Treaty of Waitangi. The children are learning about the reasons for the treaty, what happened when the Treaty was signed and why the Treaty was interpreted differently and the impact this has had.

As you will already know 'on a normal day' children are expected to do one hour of maths, reading and writing each day. In Maths they are spending the first 5 weeks focussing on addition and subtraction. In Writing the main focus is on recounts. Writing will also include spelling and handwriting. Spellings will be sent home each Monday for a test on Friday. The children have notebooks which need to be brought to school each Friday.

In PE the children are learning more games skills. We will continue to use House of Science kits to teach science.

We have begun learning both Te Reo and tikanga Maori weekly using a website called Te Puna Reo. I will be sending more information home later about this website once the whanau portal opens.

Next week Tui class will explain what they are learning.
